Olmsted, D.D., of the Watchman and Re ctor, arrived too late for the festivities, but made one of a party in an excursion to the old Blackman House to see the room where, fifty years before, the thirty-five constituent members of the church signed their names to the Covenant and Articles of Faith. In the evening, an interesting meeting was held in the chapel; where former preachers took part in the services, and closed with worship a happy and memorable day. In the following history, wherever I have occasion to refer the reader to the church-records, I have inserted the text parentheses containing the figures of the page. Proper names introduced in capitals are those of pastors or evangelists of the church. Tables of statistics and other important particulars respecting the church, which would have embarrassed the pages of the Memorial, I have placed in the Appendix.
