In fully understanding the concept of medical signs, one must also be familiar with four main classifications: (1) anamnestic signs, which give the physician an overview of a patient's history of illness, since they usually indicate a past contraction of the disease in question, (2) prognostic signs, which often gives us an impression as to the expected course of disease of the individual, (3) diagnostic signs, to which most diseases are named because they usually point toward the accurate diagnosis, and (4) pathognomonic signs, whose presence means, beyond any doubt, that a particular disease is present. A symptom, on the other hand, is a notable deviation from usual functioning or perception noticed by an individual, which more or less indicates the presence of the disease in study, albeit subjectively. It is therefore a must to delineate clear the boundary between signs and symptoms. Both are said to be abnormal in nature and potentially useful for the accurate diagnosis of the disease being studied, but it should be noted that a symptom is something experienced by the patient himself, while a sign is usually discovered during a physical assessment or an in vitro st
